The difference you can make

Giving directly supports the work of our clergy and our church in your community. That includes the provision of traditional ministry and support for our buildings, but our work reaches far out beyond our walls, to offer help and support to those that need it most.

We support the vulnerable with pastoral care, we offer comfort to the bereaved, we visit the lonely and we provide foodbanks and community services to those in need. A gift to the church is a direct way of helping the people of your community.

We offer the love of Christ through care, compassion and comfort and your giving will help us bring light where there is darkness.

Why use Gift Direct?

Gift Direct is the way that the Church in Wales manages Gift Aid donations. Gift Aid is a UK tax incentive that enables tax-effective giving by individuals to charities in the United Kingdom. Setting up a Gift Direct payment is a way that you can directly help the work of the church at a local or national level.

- If you are tax-payer, we can claim Gift Aid on every donation, which adds 25p to every £1 received.
- No more need for spare change when going to church.
- Stay in control of your giving through our online tools: www.churchinwales.org.uk/en/clergy-and-members/gift-direct.
- Your local church knows exactly what is being received and can plan their work to fit their budget.

You are in control

Anything you choose to give will be welcomed as a generous contribution to the life and work of the Church in Wales. Your giving is confidential and can be changed in response to your own financial circumstances. You can give a one-off gift or a regular monthly amount. If you want to give to a specific church or a particular project or to the Church in Wales as whole, you can do so. The process is easy to use, flexible to your requirements and you control what you want you support and how much you want to contribute.

About Direct Debits

All banks and building societies offer the guarantee printed below:



The Direct Debit Guarantee

- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit The Representative Body of The Church in Wales Registered Charity Number 1142813 (the RB) will notify you ten working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request the RB to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by the RB or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society;
 - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when the RB asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

Look how your money has helped

Bro Tysilio on Anglesey have, in partnership with the local health board, established Camau Bach to support parents, grandparents and carers in and around Menai Bridge. Camau Bach hopes to provide vital socialising opportunities in addition to supporting those caring for children.



The Reverend Gareth Coombes and a team of dedicated volunteers from St John's Church in Nelson run the Taff Bargoed Foodbank to provide a lifeline to families who struggle to afford nutritious food. Many churches run Foodbanks as a way of serving their community and living out the Gospel message.

Church volunteers in Swansea run Baby Basics – providing starter packs of essential items for new babies and parents. They work with professional agencies to identify those in need. A Moses basket provides a safe bed and is packed with toiletries, as well as blankets, towels and baby clothes. It's a way of showing God's love in action.



Volunteers from All Saints Church in Newtown have been cooking and delivering Sunday lunches for more than 80 people since the pandemic started. It is cooked in the kitchen of a nearby school and deliveries co-ordinated from the school hall. It has now become a pan-town effort, with volunteers coming from across the community.
