Why use Gift Direct?

Gift Direct allows you to support the work of your Church or Ministry Area through a one-off payment or regular giving via Direct Debit.

You are always in control of your giving and can change what you give as needed using our online forms at:

Your local church knows exactly what is being received and can plan their work to fit their budget.

Gift Direct is fully administered by the Representative Body, including claiming Gift Aid on eligible donations, and 100% of the donations and Gift Aid are sent to your nominated church or project.

Gift Aid

Gift Aid is a UK tax incentive that enables tax-effective giving by individuals to charities in the United Kingdom.

If you are taxpayer, we can claim Gift Aid on every donation, which adds 25p to every £1 received.

Look how your money has helped

Volunteers from St Mary and St David's Church in Flint run a food club, alongside the weekly coffee morning and warm hub. Called The Table, it welcomes about 50 people who pay £2 to select 10 items of good quality food. Many churches run similar foodbanks as a way of serving their communities in times of need.



Preserving our Welsh heritage for future generations is an important part of the work of Wales' only cathedral library. Housed inside the historic St Davids Cathedral, the library looks after key documents and books, such as some of the first Welsh-language Bibles and prayer books. Several of these came to the Cathedral Library after around four centuries of use in worship in churches across Wales. The library is also a vital resource for church archivists, historians and researchers from across the world.

Part of a graveyard has been transformed into a garden in Llansamlet, Swansea. The Llansamlet Graveyard Community Garden is run by a combination of church and community members and Shine Cymru, a local organisation helping young adults with learning difficulties. Fruit and vegetables grown are given to the foodbank based at St Samlet's Church. There are plans to encourage wildlife by creating meadow areas and adding bird feeders, bat boxes, hedgehog boxes and insect hotels.



From leading worship to visiting sick and housebound people, volunteers can play a bigger part in helping churches serve their communities through our Commissioned Ministry roles. People with an active commitment to faith are supported and trained by their diocese, and work closely with clergy and other licensed ministers. The three commissioned ministry roles are Worship Leader (helping to lead or assist services), Pastoral Assistant (visiting people in need) and Catechist (helping people deepen their faith through study and reflection).

All banks and building societies offer the guarantee printed below:

The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit The Representative Body of The Church in Wales Registered Charity Number 1142813 (the RB) will notify you ten working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request the RB to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by the RB or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society;
 - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when the RB asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
